POOL RULES

POOL HOURS: Mondays: 2:00 – 10:00 pm

Tuesday – Sunday: 10:00 am – 10:00 pm.

- A. You may use your key to let in family members or your invited guests only. Once inside the pool gate area, **DO NOT LET IN ANYONE** other than a family member or an invited guest. You may not let in any other homeowner who has “forgotten their key”.
- B. A **maximum** of 4 guests (non Highland Village residents) allowed per household. The **Highland Village member must be present** with their guests.
- C. **NO** alcoholic beverages may be brought inside the pool gates **AT ANY TIME** due to liability issues. For safety reasons we strongly suggest that no alcoholic beverages be consumed less than one hour before swimming.
- D. All swimming is done **AT YOUR OWN RISK**. There is no Lifeguard. Solo swimming is prohibited.
- E. All family members and/or guests under the age of 12 **MUST** be supervised by an adult at all times inside the pool gate.
- F. **No** pets are allowed inside the pool gates.
- G. All swimmers should shower before entering the pool.
- H. **NO** running, rough play or horse-play will be tolerated at any time inside the pool gates.
- I. **NO SMOKING** will be tolerated in the pool or pool area.
- J. **NO** eating or drinking will be allowed in the pool. Food and beverages must be kept in the covered area of the pool grounds. Homeowners will be responsible physically or financially for keeping the pool and pool area clean.
- K. **NO** glass containers will be allowed anywhere within the pool gates.
- L. **NO** Skateboards allowed inside the fenced pool area.
- M. All trash must be disposed of properly.
- N. Please keep the bathrooms as clean as possible. They are there for your convenience. If there is a lack of supplies in the bathroom, please contact Learia Group at 701-8881.
If there is an emergency at the pool concerning pool equipment or the pool itself, please call Eric McMurray at 405-210-8114
- O. Observe the campers # 1 rule. “Always leave it cleaner than you found it”.
- P. **If the pool area is locked during regular hours, do not enter the pool area.**

The Highland Village Pool is viewed by the State as a public pool and undergoes random inspections by both State and County Health Departments. Any violation may cause the pool to be shut down temporarily until corrections are made.
